#### TAX EXCEEDED POWERS OF FOOD CONTROLLER bring out a large field of entries.

LONDON, July 31.—The House Lords recently dismissed an appeal by the crown from a decision of the court of appeal that the food controller had lake for minutes. The court of appeal had reversed a judgment by a lower court in favor of the crown in an action against Wilts United Dairies, Limited, for some £15,000 under five agreements dated in April and May, 1919, made between the dairy people and the food controller. The judge who tried the case in the first place held that the payments complained of were a necessary part of the scheme prepared by the food controller and were therefore not such a tax as equired the authority of the Parila

The court of appeal, on the contrary, held that the imposition of the charge of twopence a gallon as a condition of the license to trade was beyond the legal powers of the food controller, and was a levying of money for the use of the crown without grant of Parliament within the meaning of the bill of rights, and that the agreements were consequently invalid.

The House of Lords decided that the food controller had not been given power by Parliament or by the Defense of the Realm Regulations to levy any sum of money on any of the King's subjects, though he had been given drastic powers in regard to the regulation and control of the food supply. Hence the crown's appeal failed.
