FIRST SEDERUNT.

*At St. John's Church, in the City of St. John,
N. B., on the 27th day of June at 11 o'clock, a.m.*

The Synod of the Presbyterian Church of the Lower Provinces of British North America, after a sermon from the Rev. George Christie, Sermon. the moderator, from the first general epistle of John, chap. ii. ver. 15, more especially from the words "Even now there are many Antichrists," met and was constituted.

The following reports from Presbyteries were received and read, Reports of Presbyteries. intimating changes affecting the Roll of Synod, and in connection therewith, the additions made to the number of Probationers and of congregations during the past year.

DEMISSION OF CHARGE

In Pictou Presbytery by Rev. Alex. Sutherland—of the congregation Demissions. at Earltown and West Branch of River John.

In Halifax Presbytery by Rev. J. Cameron—of Gore, and Kennetcook, sections of his congregation. By Rev. A. Stuart—of Musquodoboit Harbor, Clam Harbor and Meagher's Grant, being sections of his congregation.

In Prince Edward Island Presbytery—Rev. Hugh McMillan of Murray Harbor congregation.

INDUCTION.

By Pictou Presbytery, on the 4th day of June, Rev. Alexander Sutherland to the charge of the congregations of Roger Hill and West Branch of River John, now united.
