The popular press of the country are making no little trouble for the dectors by the prominence it gives to sensational departures Almost the first question the doctor can expect to hear when called to attend a child with a sore throat is "Doctor. do you use anti-toxin?" It is useless for the conservative and careful physician to attempt to explain his reasons for not employing so doubtful a resource : he finds his unscientific questioner already "informed" upon the "latest demonstrations of science" by the "popular" (if unscientific) press which "educates" the masses; and the doctor cannot be up with the times in his craft if he does not ready primed for the veins of the helpless pationt.

The spirit of knowledge exists every where. Those whose minds are in harmony with knowledge can take it.
