I should think it would be well to enlarge the list a little, however, as, for instance, where he says, "For fever take Aconite." I should add for a cold take Aconite immediately. For a cold with a tendency to go down (on the lungs or bronchial tubes) take Sticla pulmonaria 0, in one drop doses, hourly. This remedy can be taken in alternation with Aconite and is a most valuable one.)

Again I would say, for a colic which

comes and goes take Colocynth

Colocynth is excellent, also, for cramps and for "leg-ache." For constipation take *Nux vomica*.

Pardon my making these suggestions, as I am only a layman, but as I have used homopathic remedies for thirtyfour or thirty-five years, in my family and for others, long experience may count for something.
