

It is further understood that the provisions of the present treaty apply to British subjects shall be deemed also to apply to natives of any protectorate or protected territory to which the stipulations of the two preceding articles apply or shall hereafter apply.

TREATY SERIES, 1928

The present treaty shall come into force ten days after its publication in conformity with the forms prescribed in the laws of the High Contracting Parties. It may be terminated by either of the High Contracting Parties by notice not exceeding one year and not less than six months.

It shall be ratified and the ratifications shall be exchanged at Ottawa (Kovno) as soon as possible.

In witness whereof the respective plenipotentiaries have signed the present treaty and affixed their seals at Ottawa (Kovno) this 18th day of September, 1928.

Done at Ottawa (Kovno) the 18th day of May in the year 1926
