Test/Inspection Equipment

Business Machines, including Computers

Industrial Products, including Power Generation & Telecommunications

Transportation Equipment - Helicopters, Ships and Special Purpose Vehicles

A significant number of the end-user item manufacturers also produce a number of their component, subsystem and system requirements, based on need or a desire to maintain manufacturing capability of certain important items. Many New England end item manufacturers are evaluating their past make/buy decisions based on their current capabilities.

A large number of the equipment manufacturers detailed in this study are involved in the metal fabrication and machining business as well. A large portion of these companies are in the aerospace/defence industry.

Finally there are two very different segments of the Commercial Electronics Industry - Commercial Customers (either "further manufacturers" or industrial end-users) and Military/Defence Customers (either direct sale to the U.S. or other foreign government, or in a subcontract role to another company).
