

ARTICLE II

Legal Status

The University shall have the legal status as specified in Article XI of the Charter of the University, and in this Agreement.

ARTICLE III

Academic Freedom

The University shall enjoy the academic freedom required for the achievement of its objectives, with particular reference to the choice of subjects and methods of research and training, the selection of persons and institutions to share in its tasks, and freedom of expression.

ARTICLE IV

Inviolability and Protection

1.
 - (a) The premises of INWEH shall be inviolable. The appropriate authorities shall not enter the premises to perform any official duties therein except with the express consent of, and under conditions approved by the Director, or at his request;
 - (b) The University shall not permit its premises to become a refuge from justice for persons who are avoiding arrest or service of legal process or against whom an order of extradition or deportation has been issued by the appropriate authorities;
 - (c) Nothing in this Agreement shall prevent the reasonable application by the appropriate authorities of measures for the protection of the premises against fire or other emergency requiring prompt protective action;
 - (d) The premises shall be used solely to further the purposes and activities of the University;
 - (e) The Director shall, upon request, make suitable arrangements to enable the appropriate persons to inspect, repair, maintain, reconstruct and relocate utilities, conduits, mains and sewers within the premises of INWEH, and to carry out safety and occupational health measures.
2. The appropriate authorities are under a special duty to take reasonable steps to protect the premises of INWEH against any intrusion or damage and to prevent any disturbance of the peace of the premises of INWEH or impairment of the dignity of the University.
3. Except as otherwise provided in this Agreement or in the Convention, the laws of Canada shall apply within the premises of INWEH. However, the premises of INWEH shall be under the immediate control and authority of the University which may establish regulations for the execution of its functions therein.
4. The archives of the University shall be inviolable.
