CHINESE EARTH STATION
ANTENNA CONTRACT FOR
SPAR AEROSPACE LIMITED

On behalf of the Hon. Edward C. Lumley, Minister of Trade, Mr. Hal Herbert, M.P. for Vaudreuil announced today the signing by Spar Aerospace Ltd. of two contracts with the People's Republic of China. The contracts, valued in excess of one million dollars, were awarded after a keen competition. They call for Spar to provide equipment and services to modify satellite earth station antennas at Beijing (Peking) and Shanghai.

The work will be performed by Spar's Communications systems Division in Ste-Anne-de-Bellevue, Quebec.

Spar Aerospace Limited is a Canadian-owned public company engaged in the design, development, manufacture and servicing of systems and products for the aerospace, communications, aviation, defence and mapping markets.
