CANADIAN COMMERCIAL CORPORATION AWARDS CONTRACT TO RENWICK OF CANADA INC.

Mr. Jacques Guilbault, Member of Parliament for Saint-Jacques, Quebec announced today on behalf of the Honourable Gerald Regan, Minister of State (International Trade), that Canadian Commercial Corporation (CCC) has awarded a contract valued at \$194,000. to Renwick of Canada Inc., Montreal, Quebec for the supply of 8,000 medical bags to the United Nations International Childrens Emergency Fund (UNICEF). This is the third contract for medical bags awarded to Renwick by UNICEF through CCC. The value of the three awards totals \$1,641,046.

The medical bags are for worldwide distribution by UNICEF and will be used to carry surgical equipment. Renwick won this latest contract against international competition from Europe, the U.S., and Thailand. The design and high quality workmanship of the medical bag, as well as the Company's good performance were important factors in enabling Renwick to maintain this business.

Canadian Commercial Corporation contracts with foreign governments and international agencies on behalf of Canadian suppliers of goods and services. In 1981-82, CCC achieved sales of over \$550 Million involving 435 Canadian firms and more than 50 foreign governments and international agencies.
