By leave of the House, Mr. Breithaupt, from the Standing Committee on Railways, Canals and Telegraph Lines, presented the Fifth Report of the said Committee, which is as follows:—

Your Committee has considered the following Bills and has agreed to report them without amendments, viz:—

Bill No. 238 (Letter B-8 of the Senate), "An Act to incorporate Interprovincial Pipe Line Company."

Bill No. 240 (Letter D-8 of the Senate), "An Act to incorporate Westcoast Transmission Company Limited".

Bill No. 241 (Letter E-8 of the Senate), "An Act to incorporate Trans-Northern Pipe Line Company".

Bill No. 242 (Letter F-8 of the Senate), "An Act to incorporate The British American Pipe Line Company".

Bill No. 243 (Letter G-8 of the Senate,) "An Act to incorporate Western Pipe Lines".

With regard to Bill No. 240 (Letter D-8 of the Senate), intituled: "An Act to incorporate Westcoast Transmission Company Limited", and Bill No. 243 (Letter G-8 of the Senate), intituled: "An Act to incorporate Western Pipe Lines", the capital stock consists of 5,000,000 and 2,500,000 shares respectively of no par value. As, however, no provision is made in Standing Order 93(3) for the levying of a capital stock charge on stock of no par value, your Committee recommends that, for taxing pruposes, the no par value stock, in the case of these two bills, be fixed at \$10.00 per share.

By leave of the House, on motion of Mr. Breithaupt, the recommendation contained in the Fifth Report of the Standing Committee on Railways, Canals and Telegraph Lines, presented this day to the House respecting capital stock charges on Bill No. 240 (Letter D-8 of the Senate), intituled: "An Act to incorporate Westcoast Transmission Company Limited", and Bill No. 243 (Letter G-8 of the Senate), intituled: "An Act to incorporate Western Pipe Lines," was concurred in.

A Message was received from the Senate informing this House that the Senate has agreed to the amendments made by the House of Commons to the Bill No. 190 (Letter Z-3 of the Senate), intituled: "An Act respecting Oil or Gas Pipe Lines", without any amendment.

On motion of Mr. St. Laurent the House then adjourned at 11.35 o'clock, p.m., until to-morrow at 11 o'clock, a.m. pursuant to Special Order made this day.
