Appropriation and Tax Bills, etc.—Continued.

—Of unappropriated Revenue Fund for Public Service, 106.

Argenteuil—One of the 12 Electoral Districts whose limits are not to be altered, unless the 2nd and 3rd readings of the Bill be concurred in by a Majority of the members representing the 12 Districts, and an address be presented to the Lieutenant Governor, stating the fact, 80.—See 2nd Schedule.

Armed Forces—The Command in Chief of the Land and Naval Militia, and of the Naval and Military Forces, is vested in the Queen, 15.

Armouries, Drill Sheds, Military Clothing, Munitions of War and Lands set apart for public purposes belong to Canada, 108. See 3rd Schedule, (10).

Articles of Provincial Growth or Produce. Are admitted free from one Province into the other, 121.

Assembling of Parliament and Legislatures. See Meeting of.

Assent to Bills—See Royal Assent.

Assets (all) From a Public Debt assumed by a Province, belong to it, 110.

—belonging to Ontario and Quebec, 113. See 4th Schedule.

Asylums, Hospitals (Marine excepted) and Charities in Provinces, under their exclusive control, 92 (7).

Auctioneer Licenses—See Licenses.

Aylmer Court House—Joint property of Ontario and Quebec, 113—See 4th Schedule.
