Dear Professor Adams

You are I understand President of the International Geological Congress. A Spaniard on our staff, Mr Joseph Pigeon, is very anxious to know whether you would consider an invitation from the Spanish Government to hold your next meeting in Spain? He has spoken to me a couple of times about the matter and has asked me to write you in regard to it. In conversation with Prof. A. B. Coleman and Prof. A. C. Lawson of California not long since they expressed the opinion that Spain would offer considerable advantages as a meeting place for the Congress. They were also under the impression that you had no place immediately in view for the next meeting! I tried to get Prof. Coleman by telephone yesterday but was unable to do so.
