

RURAL SCHOOL CONDITIONS IN PROVINCE OF QUEBEC

with the assistance of the officials of the Department, the following survey has been prepared which should be of great interest to the members of the Protestant Committee. A somewhat similar survey was made by Dr. Darmelée and his staff in 1922 and many of the figures quoted are by way of comparison as between the survey of 1922 and 1930.

You will see from this that 25% of the total number of schools remained open 8 months or less. This does not mean that 25% of the total of more than 22,000 children enrolled in those schools were getting only training for 8 months or less but if you put the average attendance at the 185 schools open 8 months or less at 15 per school, it means that somewhere between 2000 and 2250 children or about 10% are getting training for only 8 months. In this statement no account is taken of the schools in St. Lambert, Verdun, Lachine and Westmount.

The outstanding feature of the above figures is the decrease in the number of uncertificated teachers during the period covered and the increase in the number of schools open for 10 months of the year.

The school attendance in some of the larger counties will be of interest to the members of the Committee. Only those counties having a large number of pupils enrolled are mentioned here.
