

# Par Mining Issues Aeroplaning Again---Big Cobalts Are Soaring

## LITTLE CHANGE IN GRAIN QUOTATIONS

Foreign Cables Led to Early Selling, But Early Loss Was Recovered.

CHICAGO, Jan. 28.—Wheat and corn were steady today, while oats and provisions declined. Trade was generally dull. Reselling of wheat in France reported in the quotations from Paris and Liverpool, brought about selling in this market early. There was not a great deal of it, but at that it was more than recovered. There were rumors of export sales at Marseilles, and these were denied as persistently as they arose, while the European visible increased as much as the American visible decreased. Winnipeg reported that only 1 per cent. of the crop remains in farmers' hands, the crop having been marketed with remarkable celerity, owing to the fine weather. Seaboard clearances 450,000, primary receipts 880,000, against 492,000 last year. Corn fluctuated nervously between narrow limits, but the main influence in a net decline of 3-8 to 1-2 for May was the unloading of a local long line, of which process shorts took advantage. Oats were sold on a small scale by pit traders, while demand came from commission houses, when shorts discovered the nature of the support they covered, and the early decline was recovered. Provisions started higher on the commission house demand, but there was plenty for sale on the bulge, and the close was at a net decline of 5c.
