## PREFATORY NOTE

This study of the Anglo-Saxon Scop was presented to the University of Toronto, as a thesis for the degree of M.A., in 1902. As examiner in the subject I drew the attention of the Editor of the University Studies to the essay and recommended it as one suitable for publication.
