Toronto, July 21.—Wheat steady at 68c for white and red and 67c for goose west. Manitoba wheat steady; No. 1 hard, 79c. Flour, dull; cars of straight roller in barrels, 82 1/2c. Millfeed steady at 14c to 15c for shorts, and 11c to 11 1/2c for bran west. Corn—Canada yellow nominal at 35c west; No. 2 American, 41c. West. Oats steady at 29c for white west. Peas steady at 61c to 62c west. Eggs firm at 15 1/2c to 16c. Butter steady at 13c to 14c for choice dairy pails and tubs, and 10c to 12c for inferior; creamery, 17 1/2c for prints, and 16 1/2c to 17c for boxes and tubs.

NEW YORK, July 22.—Flour—Receipts, 21,001 bbls; sales, 2,700 packages; state and western was steadier in tone, but not notably higher. Minnesota patents, \$3 75 to \$3 85. Rye flour—Dull. Wheat—Receipts, 143,900 bu; sales, 645,000 bu; options, No. 2 red was fairly active and firm this morning on hot weather news from the Northwest and as to earnings. It later eased off through realizing; July, 75 1/2c to 75 3/4c; Sept., 75 1/2c to 75 3/4c; Dec., 75 1/2c to 75 3/4c. Rye—Steady; state, 56c; No. 2 western, 60 1/2c. Corn—Receipts, 158,925 bu; sales, 25,000 bu; options, No. 2 was stronger on a demand from shorts and sympathy with wheat. Oats—Receipts, 60,200 bu; options, No. 2, were neglected. Butter—Receipts, 4,314 packages; steady. Cheese—Receipts, 1,081 packages; firm. Eggs—Receipts, 6,203 packages; steady. Sugar—Raw firm; refining, 3 1/2c; centrifugal, 9c test, 4 1/2c refined steady. Hops—Quiet. Lead—Quiet; exchange price, \$4 56 to \$4 57 1/2.
