144 ENLISTED IN DISTRICT DURING PAST FORTNIGHT

Reports for Past Two Weeks About Average.

Complete recruiting returns for this district reached military headquarters today, showing that 144 men joined the colors during the first half of September in Western Ontario.

This is about the same as the figures for several similar periods of late. At the London Mobilization Centre 62 men were attested, while at the Windsor centre 82 joined up. Eighteen of those who passed through the London centre were sent here by the British-Canadian Recruiting Mission in the United States. Infantry units obtained 53 men, forestry and railway construction ten men, and other branches of the service, 81 men. At Woodstock six men signed up, at Sarnia three, and at Galt twelve.




