SAYS GERMANY READY FOR CONCILIATORY PEACE

Article by Socialist in Vorwaerts Opposes Propaganda for Present Now Being Preached.

Amsterdam, Sept. 7.—The overwhelming majority of the German people are for a peace by conciliation, according to a new article by Philip Scheidemann published in *The Vorwaerts*. The article urges the imperial chancellor to discredit the present German manoeuvres for a "Hindenburg peace."

The Socialist leader says that no one in Germany wants peace at any price, but that those who live with the people know the real feelings of the German people. "The German people will defend herself to the last,"
