ments more than once for aid to erect suitable memorials, one in memory of those who fell at the famous Battle of Lundy's Lane, and another in memory of Mrs. Laura Secord, of 1813 fame.

The Lundy's Lane Historical Society has issued several valuable historical pamphlets.

The annual celebration has been very largely attended from the commencement.

The re-interment of eleven soldiers, killed at the battle and found at a distance, was largely witnessed Oct. 17th last.

Open meetings have been frequently held during the winter season for the reading of historical papers, the last season excepted, owing to the epidemic.
