FIRST GERMAN GUNS CAPTURED IN BIG DRIVE

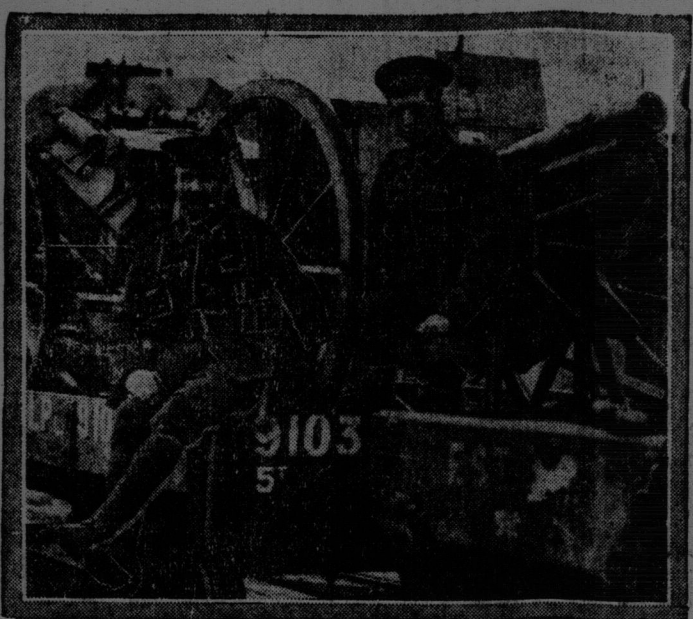


Photo shows a few of the German guns captured by the British near the Somme, being transported to the rear to be put on exhibition later in England.
