How to Preserve Eggs

During the month eggs are exceedingly cheap, and those who are anxious to preserve a supply for use during the coming winter should lose no time in making the necessary preparations.

It is necessary, whatever system is employed, to use absolutely new-laid eggs for the purpose. It is folly trying to keep eggs that are several days old when placed in the preparation.

The most ancient method of preserving eggs, but notwithstanding this, one of the best, is by means of lime, salt, and water.

An advantage of this system is that a few eggs can be added day by day as laid, so assuring their absolute freshness.
