

Omelets, Plain and Fancy

Eggs are so easily prepared that it would seem that every one should know the seven hundred different ways of preparing them, that it is said every French chef must master before receiving his diploma. Yet I know seven hundred different women who cannot make an attractive dish of fried eggs, whose boiled eggs are always too hard or too soft and who vow they will never attempt an omelet.

And there is nothing so simple in the whole line of cookery as this same omelet, it is only a mass of finffy bubbles and all that is needed to insure its beautiful lightness is a little care.

The trouble with omelets is that they stick—to prevent this rub the frying pan, or the omelet griddle, with a piece of suct or a cloth dipped in dripping, wipe it off and then butter it and pour on the egg mixture. It is the butter that sticks, you see; not the eggs, and this simple trick prevents all this.

If the shelf of baby's high chair is covered with white ollcloth, it will be much easier to keep clean.

Tomato seeds of the earliest variety should be planted in a box in the house about the 1st of March.

Collars on coats and waists are both open and high.
