LONDON, Nov. 2.

Breadstuffs.

The Russian authorities are investigating the circumstances of the publication of the official correspondence between the Russian and German governments.

The difficulties in the way of foreign powers seeking treaties with Russia are independently of the Paris conference.

The Turkish ambassadors at St. Petersburg, Berlin and Vienna have been instructed that the treaty of Paris must be maintained. Should it be violated in this case, the signatory powers will be appealed to. If, however, Romania will submit the question to the Porte, a satisfactory compromise is possible.

A Buenos Ayres report states that a battle occurred on the 20th ult., near the mouth of the Rio Salado, with rebels under Mitre, both parties claiming victory.

Selling Liquor without License.

Joe Phillips, of West Troy, Pa., this morning in the Police Court, charged with selling liquor without license. The witness in the case was Catherine Jenkins, who got drunk and was arrested Sunday. She testified to getting some of liquor, "like brandy," and that it made her drunk. It was not ginger ale. For the defense Phillips, who conducted his own case, brought three witnesses. His first witness, a young man named Johnson, attested the fact that he was with Phillips when he purchased port wine and brandy in Phillips' saloon. The other witnesses were two women and a man, who said they knew nothing of Miss Jenkins buying liquor. Further, they said she was drunk when she went to the house. The Magistrate, on the evidence of his own witness, found him guilty, and fined him \$40. Phillips said he would go to jail, but he would appeal to another court. The Magistrate told him he would issue a warrant for his arrest.
