

Ottawa, Oct. 16.—At the opening of the House to-day S. W. Jacobs asked whether the Government has received a communication from the council of the Board of Trade to Montreal asking that the steps to acquire the Grand Trunk Railway be deferred.

He said on behalf of the Acting Prime Minister that two or three communications had been received conveying the sentiments of the Montreal Board of Trade.
