TWO NEW TRAINS ARE TO BE ADDED

Partial G.T.R. Pre-War Service Will Be Restored.

On June 29th a new time table will come into effect on the Grand Trunk Railway. At this date it is known that there will be local benefits.

While details are still unknown this much can be said after enquiry at the local station that there will be two new trains between Stratford and Toronto. One will go east early in the morning and another west about six o'clock in the evening. The exact time of arrival and leaving and the facilities in coaches are as yet not known.

The putting on of these two trains means the restoration of a partial pre-war service.
