## C A P. IX.

An Act to continue, until the Twentieth Day of February One thousand eight hundred, several Laws relating to the Prevention and Punishment of Attempts to feduce Perfons ferving in His Majefty's Forces; to the empowering His Majefty to accept the Services of fuch Parts of the Militia of this Kingdom as may offer to ferve in Ireland; to the Admission of certain Articles of Merchandize in neutral Ships, and the iffuing of Orders in Council for that Purpose; to the authorizing His Majesty to make Regulations refpecting the Trade to the Cape of Good Hope; to the establishing Courts of Judicature in the Island of Newfoundland; to the enabling His Majesty to permit Goods to be imported into this Kingdom in neutral Ships; and to continue, until the Thirtieth Day of September One thousand eight hundred, an Act of the last Selfion of Parliament, for enabling His Majefty to prohibit the Exportation, and permit the Importation of Corn, and for allowing the Importation of other Articles of Provision, without Payment of Duty.
