I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant with reference to the employment of Mr. S. E. Dafoe at the Blackfoot Agency, and for your information I quote a telegram which I have sent to Mr. Gooderham today:

"MR. DAFOE'S STRVICES SHOULD NOT BE RETAINED AFTER TODAY STOP REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION OF HIS EMPLOYMENT SINCE NOVEMBER FIFTEENTH BEFORE TREASURY BOARD AND APPROVAL NOT YET OBTAINED"

Mr. Dafoe's salary to December 15 will be paid as soon as we receive the authorization of the Treasury Board which we hope will be at an early date. I regret that under existing conditions, Mr. Dafoe's services could not be retained to the end of the month.
