I telephoned Mr. Justice Mackinnon this morning to let him know that the Prime Minister had mailed a letter to him last night which associated him with the ceremony on Saturday. I explained that it was not possible for the Prime Minister to go to Montreal. Judge Mackinnon said that messages would not be read at the service, which would be of a very brief and simple nature, but would be given to the press on Saturday.
