The works of every incorporated company in Canada which is comprised in National Railways but has not been incorporated by or under the law of Canada are hereby declared to be works for the general advantage of Canada, and every such company is, by force of this Act and without 40 more, re-incorporated in its present name, with its present undertaking and in succession and continuity as respects all its affairs, by, under and subject to the provisions of this Act.
