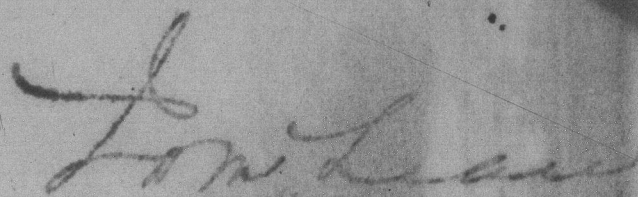
OTTAWA, 27th November, 1901:
