In reply to your letter of the 15th instant, regarding the proposal ~~pass~~ to repair the roads on the Edmundston Reserve, the cost of which is not to exceed \$100.00, I beg to say that the Department notes the conditions under which the Indians are willing that the expenditure shall be made and charged against their capital funds. Before any action can be taken in the matter it will be necessary to obtain the sanction of His Excellency the Governor General in Council to the expenditure. An Order in Council will be applied for and when passed you will be advised. You should therefore await further instructions.
