I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 1st instant in reference to the Elgin Cape Croker school, and in reply to say that providing the concrete of closets have not been completed this portion of the work should not be proceeded with until favourable weather in the spring. However, in the meantime it will be necessary, providing the school <sup>the</sup> be occupied before completion of the closet, to have temporary conveniences arranged for the use of the staff and pupils. The temporary accommodation provided for the workmen may be sufficient for the purpose.
