PASSPORTS DISCUSSED

Negotiations Under Way
With U.S., King Says

Ottawa, June 13.—(P)—The question of passports and visas for persons crossing the Canada-United States border is receiving the attention of the two governments concerned, Prime Minister Mackenzie King told a questioner in the House of Commons today.

What would be done by Canada was a matter of government policy which would be announced at the proper time.

Dr. H. A. Bruce (Con. Toronto-Parkdale) raised the question. He asked if action of the United States in requiring passports and visas from Canadians visiting the United States would result in the Canadian Government imposing similar restrictions on United States visitors entering Canada.
