TECHNICAL RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE MINISTER OF RECONSTRUCTION

A. APPLICATIONS RECOMMENDED FOR APPROVAL:

IT WAS RESOLVED

THAT the Minister of Reconstruction be advised that the Board of Governors of the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation recommends that the following applications be granted for the reasons indicated:

(a) For Changes to Existing Stations:

<u>Station</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Request</u>
CHWK	Chilliwack, B.C.	Power increase <u>from</u> 100 watts <u>to</u> 250 watts.
<u>Reason:</u> The power increase is technically possible and it is desirable to improve local service.		
CHWK	Chilliwack, B.C.	Transfer licence <u>from</u> "Chilliwack Broadcasting Co." <u>to</u> "Fraser Valley Broadcasters Ltd."
<u>Reason:</u> There is no change in the control of the station.		
CKCK	Regina, Sask.	Broadcast pick-up licence (mobile)
<u>Reason:</u> Such licence and transmitting equipment is desirable to facilitate the broadcasting of events located remotely from wire line facilities.		
CJFX	Antigonish, N.S.	Transfer of shares as follows:
1 share <u>from</u> Mrs. P. Gallagher deceased 156 Broadway St., Sydney, N. S. <u>to</u> A. Gallagher, 156 Broadway St., Sydney, N.S.		
1 share <u>from</u> Rev. C. E. Miller estate, Lourdes, N.S. <u>to</u> A. D. Rankin, St. Peters, N.S.		
1 share <u>from</u> Katie J. MacNiel, New Waterford, N.S. <u>to</u> A. S. MacIntyre, Antigonish, N.S.		
1 share <u>from</u> Rev. A. Bourdeau, L'Ardoise, N.S. <u>to</u> Rev. M. E. McLaughlin, Antigonish, N.S.		
<u>Reason:</u> These transfers do not change control of the station.		
CFBG	St. John, N.B.	Frequency change <u>from</u> 1470 kc. <u>to</u> 930 kc.
<u>Reason:</u> The change is technically possible and it is desirable to improve the primary service area of the station.		
CFAB	Windsor, N.S.	Power increase <u>from</u> 100 watts <u>to</u> 250 watts.
<u>Reason:</u> The power increase is technically possible and it is desirable to improve local service.
