THE HOMEWOOD SANITARIUM is pleasantly situated amongst picturesque surroundings on the outskirts of the City of Guelph, which is the county town of Wellington, and the centre of one of the most prosperous farming communities in Ontario. Its situation is fully 800 feet higher than Lake Ontario, which is twenty-five miles to the south. It is one of the healthiest cities in North America. Guelph streets are wide, and the houses are, for the greater part, built of the clean gray stone that is quarried in the neighborhood. At the extreme west end of the city lies the group of buildings that comprise the Homewood Sanitarium, which nestle among its own trees, and is separated from the city by the calm, placid waters of the River Speed. Its situation is an ideal one. It is the essence of peace and restfulness, without any suggestion of loneliness. It is the very spot for successful treatment of patients suffering from nervous and mental disquietude.
