

FORM OF DEVISE OF REAL ESTATE.

I give and devise unto "The Rector of the Parsonage or Rectory and Parish Church of Montreal," called Christ Church Cathedral, in his official and corporate capacity, all _____

together with all the appurtenances, tenements and hereditaments thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, to be held and possessed by the said Rector and his successors in the said Rectory and their assigns forever. And I direct that the said devise shall be held by the said Rector and his successors in the said Rectory; as a Permanent Endowment of the said Church, and that the sale and reinvestment of the proceeds of the said devise, when necessary, shall be made by the said Rector, in the said capacity, and in accordance with the advice of the "Rector and Church-Wardens" of the said Church, and after conference with the Select Vestry of the said Church; and that the Annual Income of the said devise shall be passed through the Accounts of the Church-Wardens of the said Church, and shall be applied to the payment of* _____

of the said Church, and to no other purpose.
