46. Recompense to no man evil for evil. (Rom. xii. 17.)

47. Lie not one to another. (Col. iii. 9.)

48. Take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness. (Luke xxi. 34.)

49. Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers. (Eph. iv. 29.)

50. Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain. (Ex. xx. 7.)

51. Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh. (Matt. xxv. 13.)
