ECLIPSES.—In the year 1873 there will be four eclipses—two of the Sun and two of the Moon:

1st.—A total eclipse of the Moon, May 22nd, invisible in Europe and Africa.

2nd — A partial eclipse of the Sun, May 26th, visible to Europe.

3rd.—A total eclipse of the Moon, November 4th, partly visible to North-western part of North America.

4th.—A partial eclinse of the Sun, November 19th, visible around the South Pole.
