Yet they are subjects on which we beg leave to offer to Your Excellency our sincere congratulation.

We participate with great pride and satisfaction, in your Excellency's congratulations on the success with which the Almighty has blessed His Majesty's Arms in a more remote scene, where British valour has appeared in its native vigour. The splendid Victories lately achieved in *Spain* by General the Marquis of *Wellington*, give us great cause for additional exultation, and encourage the expectation that the miseries which have so long desolated *Portugal*, and *Spain* are at length arrested in their course.

We will receive a statement of the Provincial Revenue of the Crown and of the expenditure, for the last twelve months, with the respectful attention due to every communication from Your Excellency. We learn with regret, that there is a decrease in the revenue of the last year ; but Your Excellency may rely, that being fully impressed with the importance of the objects for which we are contending, every measure will be cheerfully adopted, not only to make good the deficiency, but in granting such further aids, as shall be thought requisite and adequate to the present emergency, so far as our means will admit ; trusting to a continuation of that liberality which we have ever experienced from the Mother Country.
