Big Increase In the Price of School Books

Although school books have steadily advanced in price the last two years, the provincial government's school book department is still supplying them as the price fixed nearly welve years ago. This means that they are being sent out at a loss in some instances of more than one hundred per cent, and the people who have children of school age are reaping the benefit of it. For upwards of a month past the department has been sending out from \$2,000 to \$3,000 worth weekty, the shipments baing made to every part of the province. It is estimated that the revenue from school books for the year will amount to \$20,000 while the expenditure will be in excess of \$40,000. The advance in the cost has been general all along the line. For instance readers which sell at 3 cents costs 7½ cents and the tencent ones, 25 cents. The government has to pay a sales tax on all purchases in addition 19 the freight and cattage, but the tax is not passed along to the vendors. A discount of fifteen per cent on the purchase price is allowed to the vendors.
