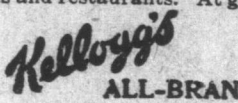

King and Many Ministers Defeated But Result Indefinite

Order Restored in Syria—Bulgarians and Greeks Retire Behind Their Own Boundaries

OTTAWA, Oct. 30. Canada's general election ends with the King and many Ministers defeated but the result is indefinite. The House of Commons today voted 118 to 97 against the Conservative government.
