The number of lawyers in the United States is reported at 31,989; and their aggregate annual earning at \$53,973,000, an average for each of \$2,000. Of these lawyers, 2,682 are residents of New York city, 695 of Philadelphia, and 648 of Boston. Other American cities have smaller numbers of lawyers.
