

TORONTO MYSTERY HAS NEW TURN

Believed Recent Murder in the Hydro Yards Was to Destroy Evidence.

COVER STEALINGS

On Theory "Dead Men Tell No Tales" -Slaying Deliberately Planned.

Toronto, April 10. - As the police proceed with their invest gation into the Rosenthal murder, the motive of robbery seems to lose impor-Every clue has been lowed by men specially detailed on the case, assisted by all the other available men in the detective department, but so far little progress has been made. Dunkelman, the second victim of the thugs, who is in the General Hospital, is recovering, and is expected to be in a condition to nake a statement soon. This the police are waiting for, to help them in the partial investigations they have already made.

One thing that is puzzling the police is the fact that Rosenthal should be the man murdered. He had no money and had not had any for some considerable time, so why, they ask, should be be murdered. As far as s known. Dunkelman had only about \$60 in his possession when he went to the hydro-electric yards, and it is apparent that the men responsible for the murder intended to do him to as well as his friend Rosenthal. But it does not seem likely that men would lure two men, one with \$60, and the other without a cent, to a lonely place, for the purpose of robbery, and the police seem to have abandoned that hypothesis.

Much Copper Stolen. There is a motive, however, behind he terrible tragedy. It is known that no little quantity of copper wire had been disposed of to second-hand dealers. The police have ascertained that certain men formerly in the employ the hydro-electric people sold stolen copper to second-hand men under cover of darkness. The police will not say what they believe to be the motive, but they have received information that the men who had been selling the stolen stuff feared that they might soon be called to task for it, as they became aware that the hydro-electric authorities had been making a secret investigation.
