EUROPEAN NEWS.

John Bright has made further progress towards recovery.

It is reported at Suakin that Osman Digna has 1,000 men and five guns at Handou.

Eight persons have been drowned by floods at Castelmagne, in the colony of Victoria.

It is semi-officially denied at Vienna that the Austrian Government intends to establish a flotta on the Danube.

Four Radical members of the Chamber of Deputies have been arrested at Belgium, on suspicion of being implicated in a conspiracy against King William.

An enormous landslide occurred on Tuesday at the mouth of the railway tunnel between Strapiail and Cannes, and the line is blocked. No one was injured.

In replying to the congratulations of the Diplomatic Corps on Tuesday, President Carnot referred to the Paris Exhibition, and said he trusted the year would be one of peace and prosperity.

The game of base ball at Melbourne on Friday between the All America and Chicago teams was won by the latter. Score: All America, 8; Chicago, 9. The teams will sail on the 7th inst.

It is reported at St. Petersburg that several persons have been arrested on suspicion of being concerned in the alleged plot between railway officials and Nihilists, the object of which was the wrecking of the Czar's train.

In his address on Tuesday Emperor William refrained from special reference to the political situation. At the reception to the foreign ambassadors, however, he is reported as having expressed his desire for the continuance of cordial relations.

The London Board of Trade has refused all applications for licenses to construct and maintain systems of electric lighting in London, merely granting instead provisional orders whose operation may be terminated at any time. These orders must receive the further sanction of Parliament.

At the instance of the leading German authorities in criminal law eminent legal men of nearly all countries have agreed to form an International Society with the object of the practical improvement of criminal laws. The agreement awaits the adherence of only England and American lawyers, the reasons for whose hesitation are unknown in Berlin.

Mr. Thomas Sexton was inducted into office as Lord Mayor of Dublin on Tuesday to serve his second term. In deference to his wishes there was no display, the usual pageant having been abandoned altogether.

The simplicity of the ceremonies has aroused a good deal of comment in Conservative circles, and the Tory Dublin Express accuses Mr. Sexton of having thereby destroyed all of the poetry attaching to the office.

The London Daily Telegraph, in a leading article on the subject of the English, says:—"We have always condescended to make them more English than they were before they came to England."

* * * Should Mr. Blaine come to London as United States Minister, Englishmen would take it as a great compliment. But whoever Mr. Harrison chooses is certain to be a *persona grata* here."

Gen. Boulanger held a reception at Paris Tuesday evening, which was very largely attended. In reply to an address from a deputation of the Patriotic League, Gen. Boulanger expressed the confidence that Paris would elect him to the vacant seat in the Chamber of Deputies for that city. During the reception a special detective watched the house and made note of those who visited the General.

At a large meeting in Dublin Tuesday Mr. Donald Sullivan, member of the House of Commons, from Southwest Meath, congratulated the leaguers on the fact that the year closes with unabated confidence in the cause. The Irish people, he said, had received a New Year's gift in the atrocious sentence of Mr. Harrington. The magistrate passing the sentence might rely on enjoying for many years the reputation of being the meanest and basest tool employed by the Balfour Government.

John Henniker Heaton, M.P., has accepted an invitation to visit the United States early this year. He expects while there to have the honor of appearing before Congress in advocacy of ocean penny postage, and much of the time will be devoted to the furthering of cheap postage.

His idea is that as letters are now carried long distances by rail at the penny rate with a profit to the post departments of England and the United States, penny postage between England and America would be perfectly feasible, indeed non-contradictory actually carry letters for the English post office from Southampton to New York for about a half penny each, that is forty letters go to the pound, and the rate paid to these non-contradictory steamers is one shilling and eight pence per pound. As to profits, Mr. Heaton calculates that the English Post Office mail would be from 50,000 to 60,000 pounds annually on the American mails. Twelve millions of letters and 2,500,000 pounds weight of newspapers, etc., were sent to America in 1887, for which the steamship companies received less than £100,000, while the English Post Office received more than £80,000 for stamps.

Collision on the Intercolonial.

Moncton, N. B., Jan. 2.—A serious collision occurred on the Intercolonial at Moncton today, about noon. A special had just arrived at the station, and had nearly come to a standstill, when the regular freight dished in from the opposite direction. A sharp curve hid the two trains from view, and a collision was then unavoidable. Both engines crashed together, and are badly smashed. About a dozen cars are more or less damaged. The men concerned have been suspended.

Blaze in Listowel.

Listowel, Ont., January 2.—The stable of S. M. Smith and Mr. Shillford were destroyed by fire at 12.45 this morning. Loss over and above insurance—Smith, \$300; Shillford, \$200. Cause of fire incendiary.

At New York Pasquale Mosera shot Eugene Boyle in the abdomen, inflicting a probably fatal wound. Mosera was arraigned in Court, and held to answer. During a fight between a number of Italians Nicol Pasquale shot Angelo Duggeria in the head, producing a probably mortal wound. Pasquale is in custody.

LABBY'S LONDON LETTER.

VIEWS OF THE EDITOR OF "TRUTH" CONCISELY STATED.

A Few Remarks on Mr. Oliphant's Death—Marriageable English Girls—The Prince of Wales Economizing, Etc., Etc.

London, January 2.—Henry Labouchere telegraphs:—There are over a million girls in England who are not likely to get married. In order to remedy this state of things I would suggest that the girls should be allowed to propose—in fact that the courting and proposing should be a business appertaining equally to both sexes.

There are a number of marriageable English girls who are shy. They have a vague and general idea of marrying, yet cannot screw up their courage to the stick-in-the-point. These were the girls who would be in addition to them, would succumb. If in addition to this parents would have the sense to leave to their daughters the same amount as to their sons, would be their intentions in this respect be known, they would speedily reduce the number of girls at present condemned to single life.

Lawrence Oliphant, who was buried last week at Wickenham, was one of the most charming companions it is possible to conceive. He seldom intruded his strange religion upon those who were bound to do so. When Oliphant first went there he was accompanied by his mother, Lady Oliphant. Harris thought them proud, and the son was ordered to work in a garden and the mother to go every day to the neighboring railroad station to sell fruit to the passing trains. Each disciple who had money spent any portion of his income that required for his personal use and handed the surplus over to Harris. It is wonderful that a man of such sound and strong intellect upon every other subject should have surrendered himself in the matter of religion to a creature like this Harris.

Sarah Bernhardt's foreign tour has been a brilliant success in all respects. But she will not derive any permanent benefit from it, as her expenses are enormous. She actually makes her net an allowance of \$1,200 a week, and her latest debt to the amount of \$140,000. Sarah and her company always lodge in the same hotel when she is on her tour, and she is a Monte-Christo-like hostess when things are going well, and she is in good humor. She is still very extravagant, and wastes large sums in buying trash of every description. Americans have been about with her. Her bills at the Austrian, Rumanian and Turkish custom houses amounted to an aggregate of \$18,000.

I believe that the Queen lately added a codicil to her will, which relates exclusively to the jubilee gifts, the value of which is very much greater than most people suppose. They have now been collected at Mr. Windsor, and there are nearly eleven hundred of them altogether.

It has been announced with some appearance of authority that Emperor Frederick intends to settle in England, and that he desires to find a permanent home near Windsor. This is all pure invention. The Emperor returns to Berlin towards the end of this month, and it is his intention to reside half of each year at Cronberg, in the Taunus, where she has purchased an estate.

The Prince of Wales intends to go to Cannes about the second week in February, and will remain in the Riviera for a month. He will while there avail himself of the recumbent effigy of the late Duke of Albany, which the Queen has presented to the new Church of St. George. The Prince has decided to effect certain economies, and at Sandringham the expenses will be considerably cut down during the coming year. One of the horse-furms will be given up, and the other will be reduced. The greater portion of the herd of shorthorns and of the flock of Southdowns will be sold off in July.

The Prince would not so wisely if he sold his racing stud and gave up racing, so far as the ownership of race horses is concerned. His speculations in blood stock have been very unfortunate, and must have cost him a considerable fortune during the last four years. It is quite true that the late Duchess of Galliera has bequeathed upwards of \$2,000,000 to the Empress Frederick, but the legacy is heavily charged and encumbered by ruinous conditions, so the Empress will probably find it expedient to refuse it.

MR. GLADSTONE'S COURSE

Attacked by His Friends in regard to a Proposed Arbitration.

London, January 2.—(Special cable)—The alarm of Mr. Gladstone's friends on account of his letter proposing arbitration between the Pope and Italy has taken shape in the suggestion that the letter may not be genuine. One of them hints that though the text may be authentic the subject to which it refers may be different from that which *The Tablet* assumes. Some denial or explanation from Mr. Gladstone himself has been anxiously awaited. Meantime the most devout among his English organs have avoided comment, and still refrain from publishing the letter. There have been very strong expressions from various quarters against the policy of interference from outside with the relations between the Pope and Italy. Even if Mr. Gladstone should contemplate nothing more than agitation against the Italian laws with reference to priests, that, too, would be deemed indication of a grave character.

The *Pall Mall Gazette* published a telegram from Mr. Gladstone saying:—Letter not new. Retranslated version published; untrustworthy statement; incorrect under present circumstances." The statement referred to appears to be the statement telegraphed him that he recommended international arbitration of the Roman question. Mr. Gladstone's reply will not dissuade the anxiety of those who regard Nonconformist support as essential to Liberal success. What was said from him is a general denial that he meant to interfere in any way in behalf of the Papal power. That denial he seems unable or unwilling to give.

A Double-hearted Negro.

Trenton, N. J., January 2.—The Mercer County Medical Society yesterday examined William King, a colored man, forty-five years of age, who was said to have two hearts. The examination proved that King has a divided heart, such as is found in the lower animal kingdom. The heart beats are perceptible on both sides.
