A GENERAL LOCKOUT IN DANBURY HAT FACTORIES.

Manufacturers Close Their Shops and Will Be Open Then as Non-Union Establishments—Four Thousand Operatives are to be Dismissed—The Outcome of the Fight.

DANBURY, Conn., Nov. 26.—The hat manufacturers of Danbury discharged their help and closed their factories Saturday afternoon, and they will not re-open them, they say, until they are opened as independent shops.

The working people feel very bitter over the attack on their organizations at a time when most of them are in a poor condition for a strike. Still, they seem determined to make a fight if they can see any possibility of success.

This is the only hint as to when the operators will be allowed to return to work. An explanatory circular issued by the manufacturers gives a history of the agreements that have been in existence between them and the several trades unions since 1885.

The novelty of the agreement, says the circular, "and the absence of any precedent in the history of the industry, made the experiment a very interesting one."
