NEWS OF THE WORLD.

British exports for the past year show a decrease of 22,000,000 sterling, due to the Dingley tariff.

The Russian government has removed the duty from agricultural implements and building timber.

Nearly 10,000 Indian coolies are now engaged in constructing the Uganda Railway, Africa.

A fund is being raised at the instance of General Lord Kitchener to fund the Gordon Memorial College at Khartoum...

Returns for eleven months, to the end of November, show that about thirty-five thousand immigrants have arrived in Canada from Europe and United States.

Lord Minto's eldest daughter, Lady Ellice Eliott, is a native of Canada, having been born at Halifax in 1849.

Last year Canada imported 1,475,385 tons of free trade cotton valued at \$5,085,160.

The banks of the Upper Province have cleared \$1,200,000 in dividends since the beginning of the year.

Over 100,000 acres of land in New York, has been arranged to make 85 miles of meadowland and 100 miles of pastureland.

The British Government has taken full possession of the Khyber pass between India and Afghanistan.
