> THE Macdonald Memorial meeting held on Thursday evening of last week appointed a very lengthy and imposing list of those who were not there as members of the Committee. The late Sir John is no hero of ours, and we do not see that the country owes him any memorial. All the same the lack of interest on the part of those who pro-fessed to idolize him, and who owe everything they are to him, is a strik-ing instance of human ingratitude, There was no particular reason why the people should have been at that by staying away. But where were the tax-enriched tariff monopolists, the North Western Syndicate land-grabbers, the boodling contractors, the lit-tle ten-cent politicians who have been feeding fat in office owing to Sir John's favors! What a scurvy set of ingrates are the crew whom he has enriched with the peoples' money!

PUBLIC opinion in the United States is crystallizing very rapidly in favor of the confiscation by the government, of a considerable proportion of the enormous fortunes, now so numerous in that country, either by means of a graduated tax on incomes or a heavy duty on inheritances. Prof. Richard T. Ely has a forcible arrow in North American Review advocating a Ely has a forcible article in the tax on inheritances, increasing as the relationship of the heir to the testator becomes more distant and as the property becomes larger. He notes fact that in Switzerland inheritances are taxed in some instances as Arena, advecates still more drastic measures in the case of deceased millionaires and would have the state take over the great bulk of their states. The notion that dead men have a right to control the disposal of what they leave is a superstition that can't be too soon got rid of.
