## WINNIPEG LIFE UNDERWRITERS' ASSOCIATION

A special meeting of the Winnipeg Life Underwriters' Association was held at the Royal Alexandra Hotel on September 27th, with J. H. Baird, newly elected president, in the chair. After luncheon, Mayor Gray spoke very highly of the good work the insurance men were doing in the city. Dr. Fraser, provincial health officer, gave an eloquent and instructive discourse on the relations of the health department and health officials to the conservation of life. He referred to the economic waste to the state, and said there were many lives which might have been saved if proper methods had been taken. He also spoke at some length regarding the rejection system, and he thought that at different points, companies should have an independent referee who could pass on cases who had been marked as defective by some examiner, so that they would not be put on the library bureau rejection card.

On September 29th, a business session was held in the board room of the Board of Trade Building, when the question of publicity was discussed at some length and referred to the executive for further information.

At this meeting the secretary and treasurer reported that they closed the previous year with a surplus.
