

EXCHANGE OF NOTES (September 20 and 30, 1965) BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE INTER-AMERICAN DEVELOPMENT BANK AMENDING THE AGREEMENT OF DECEMBER 4, 1964, IN ORDER TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR ASSISTANCE TO LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES WHICH ARE MEMBERS OF THE BANK.

DEAR MR. HERRERA:

As you know, Section 16(a) of the Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Inter-American Development Bank, signed at New York on December 4, 1964⁽¹⁾, provides that the agreement may be extended to cover any additional funds which the Government of Canada may make available for the purposes of the Agreement. Accordingly I am pleased to propose that the amount made available under Section 2(a) of the Agreement be increased from the specified initial sum of CDN \$10 million to a total of \$20 million. These additional funds will be made available on the same terms and conditions as those relating to the original Canadian contribution.

If you agree to the foregoing I propose that this letter and your reply shall constitute an amendment to the Agreement of December 4, 1964, effective the date of your reply.
