WHAT DO THEY DO?

- They are responsible for project delivery; they find the internship positions with overseas host organizations and recruit the interns.
- Together with the Department and the host organizations, they strive to ensure that each internship is a valuable international experience that enhances the intern's marketability.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED

- If an organization has international contacts and would like to develop and administer a project placing *five* or more interns, it should communicate with the Department using the contact information given at the end of this brochure.

HOST ORGANIZATIONS WHO ARE THEY?

- They are Canadian or foreign companies, non-governmental organizations, and international organizations which value the talent, skills, innovative ideas and energy of youth of Canada.

WHAT DO THEY DO?

- Host organizations provide full-time international assignments of 6-12 months duration.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED

- If an organization *would be able to host an intern overseas*, it should send a description of the proposed placement to an implementing organization (of a corresponding nature) listed on our web site, or fax it to the Department at (613) 995-7572.
